UNIFORMS REQUIREMENT FOR ALLIED HEALTH PROGRAMS

- White lab coat (optional), should be worn during lab especially in phlebotomy & clinical class.
- Plain solid navy or light blue scrub pant
- Plain solid navy, light blue or white scrub top
- Rubber sole, closed toe, non-canvas shoes (white), or nursing shoes or white crocs(no designs). White socks and/or white stocking must be worn at all times.
- No large hoop or dangling earrings / no heavy make-up or strong perfume/cologne
- No long nails and bright nail polish. Acrylic nails are prohibited because it harbors bacteria.
- No facial piercing permitted (eyebrow, nose, lip, & tongue), and anyplace else visible
- No long, heavy, thick chains or necklaces to be worn in class.
- Hair, especially long hair, extensions, braids must be pulled back or tied away from face and not hanging down.
- No hair wraps or scarf worn in hair (this excludes Rasta &/or for religious reasons)
